2. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

None.

3. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 14th September 2021 and were accepted as a true and accurate record of proceedings.

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING

4.1 Annual Dinner.

NF reported that the menu has been confirmed with South Forest staff, and that league clubs have been requested to advise the league how many tickets they require via a 'Survey Monkey' poll. The Poll closes on Friday 29 October 2021.

It is likely, at this stage, that all league clubs will be invoiced for two dinner tickets each as has been customary, however this will be reviewed once the response from league clubs has been assessed.

League clubs have been notified of award winners, although there are still a few to be decided which are at the discretion of the LMC.

A raffle will be held, and all league clubs attending are respectfully requested to donate a raffle prize.

The majority of League Trophies have been returned to SB Trophies; NF stated that he will visit SB Trophies to confirm and advise the LMC of any problems, damage, or non-returns.

Clubs will also be requested to sign to accept full responsibility for the care of trophies in their possession, ensuring adequate insurance cover and return to SB trophies by the stipulated date.

TM reported that he had confirmed arrangements with Tracey Burgin for stitching the award citations into caps and will order an appropriate number of caps from Mad Dog Sports.

It was agreed that the citation will include:

- Bassetlaw and District Cricket League
- Year
- Division

5. FINANCE & SPONSORSHIP

5.1 TM reported that the current bank balance stood at £9447.58, with £4.36 cash in hand.

£800 in fines have been collected, and a further £30 in fines is currently owed.

SAFEGUARDING AND DBS MATTERS

6.1 AW reported that the had been no further developments since the last meeting.

AW added that the ECB Safe Hands Management System will be rolled out to all clubs not yet signed up within the next 2-3 months.

League Club AGM's. AW again stressed the importance of DBS Checks, and asked league clubs to ensure that volunteers standing for team captaincy and other roles stipulated by the ECB as requiring a DBS are made fully aware of these requirements at their forthcoming Annual General Meetings.

7. DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

7.1 GV reported that a meeting has been convened at Trent Bridge on Thursday 21 October to review the County Wide Disciplinary procedure process, which will consider the experiences gained during the 2021 season. GV and DP will represent the BDCL and will report back at the November 2021 meeting.

8. CORRESPONDENCE

8.1 Formation of a development division. NF reported that five clubs had expressed interest in potentially joining a development division.

Following discussions, it was agreed that as Farnsfield CC had suggested this originally, the LMC would ask Paul Delaney to form a working group to further discussions on the formation of a development division and the appropriate playing rules. Andrew Wilson agreed to take part in these discussions; it was also decided that two members of the LMC should also be involved.

NF undertook to contact Paul Delaney about this matter and report on progress at the next LMC meeting.

8.2 Under 21 Awards.

From the statistics provided by Stef Roberts, the LMC selected the following winners of the Under 21 Awards:

- Batting-Sam Watson-Papplewick & Linby CC
- Bowling-Same Kaye-Notts & Arnold Amateurs CC
- All Rounder-Sam Kaye-Notts & Arnold Amateurs CC
- 8.3 NF reported that Gedling and Sherwood CC had made an application for their second eleven to join the BDCL. This would be a transfer from the South Notts Cricket League. It was agreed that a working party comprising GJ, DP and Paul D Barker would arrange to meet officials from Gedling & Sherwood CC to discuss this matter further and report their findings at the November LMC meeting.

9. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- 9.1 Annual General Meeting. It was noted that neighbouring cricket leagues have planned a return to 'face to face' Annual General Meetings. This matter was discussed and a final decision on the format of the 2021 AGM was deferred to the November LMC meeting.
- 9.2 Training in the use of ECB Play Cricket functions for league clubs. AW reported that this will be provided via a Webinar currently being prepared by the ECB Play Cricket administration team. Further details will be distributed to league clubs soon by the NCCC club development team.
- 9.3 2021 Club Survey Results. The findings have now been distilled and categorised into lists of matters which need to be dealt with. It was agreed that a sub committee comprising GJ, DP, NF and GV (in conjunction with MMC) be established to discuss this matter further and make recommendations to the LMC at forthcoming meetings. This will include examining the feasibility of a sponsorship and fundraising committee, to be run independently

of the LMC but reporting to it via the treasurer or an appointed representative. It was noted that a significant number of replies had been received from survey respondents indicating an interest in serving on a finance/fund raising committee.

- 9.4 2022 League Handbook. DP raised this matter and suggested that we should return to a more substantial league handbook than the one produced for the 2021 season. This matter has also been raised by league clubs and the BDUA. It was agreed that the format of the league handbook needs to be reviewed, and therefore will be placed on the agenda to be discussed further at forthcoming LMC meetings.
- 9.5 2021 League Charity (Parkinson's Disease). NF reported that he had not pursued league clubs in respect of fundraising activities towards the league's chosen charity, due to the problems encountered throughout the season because of Covid-19 and the resultant restrictions. It was therefore agreed that the league should donate to the charity in lieu of club contributions. TM suggested a figure of £500, which represents a significant proportion of the fines paid by league clubs this season. This was agreed in principle by the LMC and will be tabled at the next meeting for final agreement; this will enable TM to pay the agreed contribution before the end of the current financial year.


