3 Membership (League Rules 4.1 [2nd Paragraph], and 4.3, Document A)

Deadline updated to November, in line with current timescales regarding constitution and fixture creation.

4 Finance (League Rule 5.4, Document A)

Entrance fee for any newly admitted club increased to £35.00, to be paid not later than 31 March in any year.

5 Return of Circulated Documents (League Rule 10, Document A)

Failure by a club to return a circulated document related to the administration of the League by the due date reduced to £10.00.

6 Conceding of Matches (League Rule 11, Document B)

Any club failing to fulfil a League engagement, will face the following sanctions:

1 st Offence	£10.00 fine and a 10-point deduction.
2 nd Offence	£10.00 fine and a 20-point deduction.
Subsequent offences	£20.00 fine and a 20-point deduction.

All matches will be deemed as 'Conceded'.

7 Notification of Results (League Rule 17.1, Document B)

The Home team must record the full result on Play-Cricket on the day of the match.

The result must contain all the information required as per the Result Summary Page, i.e., Result, Won Toss, Team Batted First, 1st Inning's Score, Wickets, and Overs, 2nd Inning's Score, Wickets, and overs, plus changes to Revised or Scheduled Overs.

The home team has the full responsibility for the submission and correctness of the result.

Home teams failing to comply with this rule will receive the following sanction:

1 st Offence	£10.00 fine.
2 nd Offence	£20.00 fine.
Subsequent offences	2-point deduction.
Cup Matches	£20.00 fine.

8 Notification of Results (League Rule 17.2, Document B)

The home teams must submit a photograph of the Match team card, via email, to the Match Administrator within 48 hours of the match.

The home team has the full responsibility for the submission of the photograph of the match team card.

Home teams failing to comply with this rule will receive the following sanction:

1 st Offence	£10.00 fine.
2 nd Offence	£20.00 fine.
Subsequent offences	1-point deduction.
Cup Matches	£10.00 fine.

9 Notification of Results (League Rule 17.3, Document B)

The home team shall be responsible for the submission and confirmation of the full and complete scorecard on Play-Cricket within 48 hours of the completion of the match (midnight on Monday for a Saturday fixture).

Scorecards must contain no errors, i.e., to include all participating players in batting order and the names of players involved with catches, stumpings and run outs. The captain and the wicketkeeper must also be listed.

The home team should ensure that all the details to ensure the validity of the submission of the scorecards is received from the away team. The away team should ensure all the required details to ensure the validity of the submission of the scorecard is provided to the home team.

Teams failing to comply with this rule, or adding incorrect details will receive the following sanction:

1 st Offence	£10.00 fine.
2 nd Offence	£20.00 fine.
Subsequent offences	2-point deduction.
Cup Matches	£20.00 fine.

10 Notification of Results (League Rule 17.4, Document B)

The away team shall check and confirm all match details on Play-Cricket within a further 24 hours (midnight on Tuesday for a Saturday Fixture).

Away teams failing to do so or adding incorrect or incomplete details will receive the following sanction:

1 st Offence	£10.00 fine.
2 nd Offence	£20.00 fine.
Subsequent offences	2-point deduction.
Cup Matches	£20.00 fine.

11 Registration of Players, Annual Database Tidy (League Rule 2.11, Document D)

Registrations will be removed on an annual basis for all Category 1 Eligible, Category 2 and Category 3 players, and any player that has not played within the BDCL in the previous three seasons. In addition, registrations may be removed to maintain the integrity of the Player Registration database; clubs will be advised in such instances. Clubs that wish to retain the registration of such players will be required to re-submit as per these Rules.

Any club playing a UK-born Category 1 player whose registration was removed under this rule, will be deemed as 'Unregistered' for all games subsequently played until the registration is accepted. All other players will be deemed as 'Ineligible'.

12 Registration of Players, Sanctions (League Rule 6.x, Document D)

Category 1 players not registered as per these Rules will be deemed as unregistered.

Category 1 Eligible players, Category 2 and Category 3 players not registered as per these Rules will be deemed as ineligible.

For Cup matches, Clubs playing ineligible player(s) will automatically concede the game.

A club found to be contravening rules relating to the payment of players may, as an ultimate sanction, be expelled from the League. The minimum tariff for related offences shall be the deduction of 20 points per player per match.

13 Delayed Start, Batting Bonus Points (League Rule 16.6, Document F)

16.6 The following table displays the required number of runs required for batting bonus points in a match that is delayed or has had a pre-emptive reduction in the number of overs and is then uninterrupted.

The required number of runs required for each batting bonus point is found against the revised number of overs played, rounded down to the nearest number of overs shown in the table:
